

Dear Friends

Did you know that we are an Easter people? Two thoughts immediately spring to mind: First, as Easter people, we rejoice in the promise that death has been destroyed. It no longer holds us in its grip! So, we are not afraid, for our destiny is heaven! 'Oh, what a glorious day that will be!' The Scripture says, "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love him." (1 Corinthians 2.9)

Second, as Easter people we are filled with Easter Power. Paul writes in Ephesians 1.19-20: "... and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power for us who believe, according to the working of his great power. God put this power to work in Christ when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly places...." What amazing power God has placed in those who believe! As we say at the end of every Eucharist, "Glory to God, whose power working in us can do infinitely more than we can ask or imagine..." We would do well to meditate on the truth of that prayer. That resurrection power enables us to share the good news of the Gospel with others. Billy Graham once said in a sermon:

"It was the resurrection of Christ that caused the disciples to go out as burning young revolutionaries to change the world of their day. They preached that Christ was alive. This should be our message, not only at Easter but every day of the year. The risen Christ wants to come into our hearts today."

Gloria and children join me in wishing each of you a most blessed Easter.
