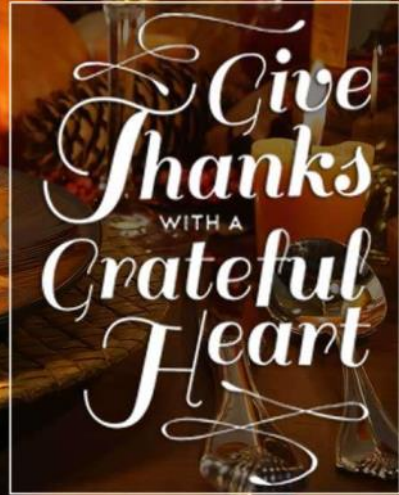

Hush Documentary

The Centre for Life will be having a viewing of the documentary Hush on Tuesday October 22 at 7:45 p.m. at Corpus Christi Complex on Waterford Bridge Road. This film has received critical acclaim around the world having been part of the "Official Selection" at 8 Film Festivals and having been honoured with 3 awards including Best Documentary in Los Angeles, A Silver Award at World Fest in Houston and a Gold Award at the The World Documentary Awards in Jakarta. The film premiered in Beverly Hills at the La Femme women' film festival where their positioning statement is "Films by women that everyone should see!" Admission is free. Director Punam Kumar Gill and producers Drew and Jose Martin were determined to put aside their individual ideology and take an honest scientific look at the highly disputed and politicized information around abortion's long - term effect on women's health. What Punam discovers in the process is not just vital to the subject of reproductive health but also critical to her own life and integral to the ongoing progress of women everywhere.
