Parish Council Highlights

- ◆ Father Darrell lead a Bible Study on 1 Timothy 1:1-2
- ◆ Because some people believe the Passing of the Peace is getting disruptive, the Council decided that it will be drawn to a close a little sooner as the musicians begin to lead in singing the offertory hymn.
- ◆ The amended By-Laws will be brought to our next meeting for approval before they are brought to a congregational meeting for ratification.
- ◆ Council discussed the lease of the parish office which is up Jan 31, 2020. The discussion focused on the need of having a parish office, and the costs associated with it. Father Darrell has been tasked with checking with other ANiC congregations to see what they do to provide clerical and pastoral space.
- ◆ Because it is necessary for our insurers, Council decided to have each member refreshed on the Plan to Protect Program.
- ◆ Father Darrell reported on the impact social media is having on our Newfoundland ANiC congregations.

- ◆ We continue to owe \$1,335.77 in outstanding debt to ANiC for the rectors salary, and we have yet been able to pay any tithe to ANiC, which means that so far this year we are behind \$8,109.59. We continue to our hope that this outstanding debt will be paid off very soon, and that we will once again be able to begin paying our tithe to the Diocese.
