Please note that St Stephen the Martyr, while having made steps to pay down in debt to ANiC, continues to owe \$1,335.77 in salary arrears, and has not paid any tithe to ANiC since 2017.

However, rent to Victory Christian Centre is paid and up-to-date, and the rent for the Office is paid and up-to-date.

It is our hope that this outstanding debt will be paid off very soon, and that we will once again be able to begin paying our tithe to the Diocese.
