**CHRIST THE KING  
SUNDAY**



Next Sunday is the last Sunday of the Christian Church Year. Christ the King Sunday is the climax and conclusion of the Church's liturgical journey through the life of Christ and the Gospel message. Its purpose is to celebrate the coming reign of Christ as King of the

Earth and his completion of the renewed creation that marks the fullness of the Kingdom of God. That hope is born from the entire life of Christ and his teachings that have been celebrated in the seasons of the Church Year during the past twelve months. This Feast also provides an appropriate bridge to the new Church Year that begins the following Sunday - the first Sunday of Advent.
