Weekly Word Readings for the week of Nov 13/22 2 Thessalonians 3:6-13 Luke 21:5-19 Psalm 98

The reading in the Psalm begins with, 'Sing to the Lord a new song for He has done marvellous things!' The Psalmist follows this with some of the marvellous things that He has done. (A reminder)

Then we are told to: shout joyfully, break forth, rejoice, sing with instruments. (**Our response**)

As we continue on the Psalmist speaks of how creation also praises referring to the sea and all of its fullness, the world and all who dwell, the rivers, and the hills together. (**Nature's response**)

Finally, The writer says these words; For He is coming to judge the earth with righteousness, He shall judge the world and the people with equity. (Fairness and impartiality).

I say, How Marvellous! Our God, the Creator promises to judge with fairness and impartiality. How patient He is with us.

2 Thessalonians 3:13 reminds us to not grow weary in doing good!

The Word of God is full of **reminders** of who He is and what He **has** done and **will** do for His children.
