## Readings for the week of April 9/23:

Acts 10:34-43

Colossians 3:1-4

On the joyful occasion of Resurrection Sunday, otherwise known as Easter Sunday, we celebrate the Lord Jesus Christ's victorious resurrection. His return to life, thus conquering sin and death, for us. All of us! He shows no partiality. (Acts 10:34) He has no "favorites".

Romans 5:8 tells us, "but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Christ died for each and every one of us, so that we could have eternal life, and live with Him forever.
