The Readings for the week of Feb. 27/22:

Exodus 34:29-35

Psalm 99

2 Corinthians 3:12-4:2

Luke 9:28-36, 37-43a

In Exodus 34:34-35, we read *“Whenever Moses went in before the Lord to speak with him, he would remove the veil, until he came out. And when he came out and told the people of Israel what he was commanded, the people of Israel would see the face of Moses, that the skin of Moses' face was shining. And Moses would put the veil over his face again, until he went in to speak with him.”*

Our countenance may not be physically shining as Moses' was, but we are reminded here that whenever we have been in the presence of The Lord, we should be changed somehow.

The same Holy Lord of heaven and earth that met with Moses invites us to come into His presence, regardless of whether or not we are a Priest. In Psalm 99: 6, we read, *“Moses and Aaron were among his priests, Samuel also was among those who called upon his name. They called to the Lord, and he answered them.”*

If you seek freedom or transformation in any part of your life, I encourage you to spend time in His presence. You'll be glad you did!

2 Corinthians 3:17-18 says, *“Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit.”*
